

Reno Municipal Court Bail Schedule

- The following is a bail schedule of charges processed through the Reno Municipal Court and may not represent the fine amount imposed upon plea or finding of guilt. The actual fine imposed in a particular case lies within the sole discretion of the sentencing judge.
- The number on the left is the Reno Municipal Code for the charge for which you were cited or arrested.
- "M" indicates Mandatory Appearance; you must appear for arraignment and trial on this charge.
- The single-digit number in parentheses after the description of the charge (moving violation) is the number of demerit points assessed by the DMV for this violation.
